## **Biblical Requirements to Serve as a Deacon**

<sup>8</sup> Deacons, likewise, should be worthy of respect, not hypocritical, not drinking a lot of wine, not greedy for money, <sup>9</sup> holding the mystery of the faith with a clear conscience. <sup>10</sup> They must also be tested first; if they prove blameless, then they can serve as deacons. <sup>11</sup> Wives, <sup>12</sup> likewise, should be worthy of respect, not slanderers, self-controlled, faithful in everything. <sup>12</sup> Deacons are to be husbands of one wife, managing their children and their own households competently. <sup>13</sup> For those who have served well as deacons acquire a good standing for themselves and great boldness in the faith that is in Christ Jesus.
